The Labor/Management Healthcare Coalition is proud to announce an exclusive offer to Fund Members and their families, effective August 1st, 2012 the Labor/Management Health Care Coalition of the Upper Midwest (LMHCC) in conjunction with the SXC Health Solutions now Catamaran will offer a private labeled Prescription Drug Discount Card program, this is an exclusive offer and Funds must be a members of the LMHCC. The LMHCC Prescription Drug Discount Card will be accepted at over 58,000 pharmacies nationwide and will reduce the Fund member's out-of-pocket expense on both brand and generic prescriptions. The discount varies by product and is typically greater on generic prescriptions than on brand products. The LMHCC pharmacy consultant, The Burchfield Group after an analysis said this is the best discount card in the market place. The LMHCC Prescription Drug Discount Card program through SXC Health Solutions now Catamaran can be combined with your current pharmacy program at no additional cost, even if the member Fund is utilizing a none-coalition pharmacy program.

The LMHCC Prescription Drug Discount Card program is a savings option that can be offered to members and families that are not currently covered on member funds plans or as a safety net for those that lose coverage for a period of time.
